Since the 2022 local elections we have continued to be active in the community, listening to your concerns and ensuring that your voice is heard in the Merton Civic Centre.

We have dealt with numerous pieces of casework each year and have addressed a number of issues that matter to residents.

Some of these have included improvements to Joseph Hood recreation ground, installation of a bund to protect our wonderful Cannon Hill Common from illegal incursions, delivering the Martin Way project with the installation of new planters and seating, supporting local community organisations in the area and finally campaigning for private investment in a pickleball centre in the currently derelict tennis courts adjacent to the Hillcross car park.

Pickleball for Cannon Hill

As residents in Cannon Hill, we too have been frustrated by the past illegal incursions on Cannon Hill Common. That is why we were pleased to deliver on our long-running campaign to protect our lovely common when the Council agreed to install a bund (an earthwork around the perimeter of the common) to protect it from illegal incursions. We are pleased that our campaign has been a success and this summer there were no illegal incursions.

A private sector group has proposed to lease the decayed and derelict tennis courts in Morden Park adjacent to the Hillcross car park and convert them to an enclosed multi use Pickleball & Paddle Ball centre. This will make good use of the derelict tennis courts by creating an excellent sporting facility and bring valuable private investment into the borough. We are working with the Council to help deliver this project.
